

Quilting 113: Carpenter Star Advanced Beginner

This traditional quilt can be made in multiple sizes and multiple color combinations. This class will focus on 8 colors with a neutral background measuring 70"x70". Additional borders can be added.* Participants will practice Half Square Triangles (HSTs) and point matching.

During class we will focus on sewing the carpenter stars for the quilt top. Supplies are listed for the entire project however you will need to complete it on your own.

Prerequisite: Quilting 101 or equivalent experience.

SUPPLY LIST FOR CLASS

- Quilting cotton for top
 - Choose one of the following combinations
 - 8 colors
 4 colors
 4 yard each color
 - 2 colors1 yard each color
 - o 2 yards for background (all color combinations)
- 4 ⅓ yards quilting cotton for backing*
- ¾ yard quilting cotton for binding*
- 2 ½ yards batting (needs to be at least 90" wide)*
- Coordinating thread for piecing & quilting (will be visible)
- Magic Wand
 - o Not required but can help aid in making your HSTs easier & more accurate

*If you add additional borders, you will need to adjust how much batting and fabric is needed for the backing and binding.

Supplies: Unless otherwise noted in the class description, supplies are not included in the class fee. Please purchase class supplies in advance at our store. Sewing Machines: If bringing your own machine, make sure your machine is in good working order and you are familiar with using it before class. Let us know when you register if you would like to use a classroom machine.
