



## **Quilting 110: Fall Pumpkin Runner Advanced Beginner/Intermediate**

It's pumpkin season and what better way to celebrate than with a pumpkin table runner? This runner will take you all the way through fall from Halloween to Thanksgiving. Using snowball corners and simple patchwork, you don't have to worry about sewing a single curve to create the pumpkins. The runner finishes at 15" x 46 ½" however you can easily customize your runner length or adapt it for a different project of your choice. A few pumpkins would make a cute wall hanging, pillow or placemat.

The pattern includes a variety of seasonal runners you can make to update your home throughout the year.

A quilt version of the pattern is available as well if you would prefer that to a runner. Please refer to the pattern for fabric amounts as they will differ from what is listed below.

*Please note we will be focusing on the quilt top during class and you will need to finish it at home. The supply list reflects what is needed to complete the project.*

### **SUPPLY LIST FOR CLASS**

- Cluck Cluck Sew Modern Holiday Table Runners pattern
- Quilting cotton
  - Orange pumpkins – 4 Fat Quarters (FQs) or large scraps
    - For best results use nondirectional fabric
  - Green leaves – 1 FQ, 1 Bits & Pieces or large scrap
  - Brown stem – 1 FQ, 1 Bits & Pieces or large scrap
  - Background fabric – ½ yard
  - Border – ¼ yard
  - Backing – 1 ½ yard
  - Binding – ⅓ yard
- Batting
  - 1 ½ yards runner batting 20" wide
- Thread for piecing & quilting

**Cancellations and Refunds:** Class fees are non-refundable unless the class is canceled by the store. Classes may be canceled if we do not have a minimum number of enrollments 48 hours prior to the beginning date of the class. Refunds are not given in the case of student cancellation, but if you have paid for a class and are unable to attend, you may send a friend in your place. **Supplies:** Unless otherwise noted in the class description, supplies are not included in the class fee. Please purchase class supplies in advance at our store. The Class Supply List is available online on the calendar item for each class. Please download and print the list when you register. You will receive a 20% discount on your class supplies when you show your registration receipt in store or use the coupon code from your class email in our webstore.

**Sewing Machines:** If bringing your own machine, make sure your machine is in good working order and you are familiar with using it before class. Let us know when you register if you would like to use a classroom machine.

**Children and Pets:** Children are not allowed in the classroom unless they are attending as a student in a class offered for children and may not be left unattended in the store while you are in class. Pets are not allowed in the classroom with the exception of service dogs.
