#### Sizes

EASY

**Skill Level:** 

Women's Small (Medium, Large, 1X, 2X) Mens Small (Medium, Large, 1X, 2X)

#### **Finished Measurements:**

Chest: 35.5 (39, 43, 47, 52); [38 (41, 45, 49, 53)]" Length: 23 (23.75, 24.5, 25.5, 27); [26 (27, 28, 28.5, 29)]"

#### Materials:

- Cascade Yarns<sup>®</sup> Pacific<sup>®</sup> Chunky60% Acrylic / 40% Superwash merino Wool 100 grams(3.5 oz), 120 yds (110 m)
- 7 (7, 8, 8, 9); [7 (8, 9, 10, 10)] skeins • color #186 (Brindle)
- US 10.5 (6.5 mm) 16", 32" Circular • needles and double point needles, US 9 (5.5 mm) 16" circular needles and double point needles, or sizes to obtain gauge.
- 4 Stitch Markers
- Yarn Needle

## Gauge:

14 sts x 18 rnds = 4" (10 cm) in Stockinette Stitch on US 10.5 (6.5 mm)

To save time, take time to check gauge by knitting a  $6^{\prime\prime}x~6^{\prime\prime}$  swatch

# Knitted Cast On

For beginning CO, make a slip knot, K into the slip knot and place the new st on needle, \*K into the new stitch and place this st on needle, rpt from\* until desired number of sts are CO

During work turn needle as if to start a new row, K into the first st and place the new st on needle, then rpt from\* until desired number of sts are CO

**Note:** Do not make CO sts too tight because you will need to PU the same sts during finishing

Note: The Knitted Cast On applies to all CO instructions

#### Pattern Stitches

**ST ST in the round** Every Rnd: K **2x2 Rib in the round** Every Rnd: \*K2, P2\* rpt btwn\*

#### **Optional Bottom Band Patt**

Rnds 1, 3, 5: K Rnds 2, 4, 6: P Rnd 7: \*K4, P4\* rpt btwn\* around Rnd 8: K3, \*P4, K4\* rpt btwn\* to last st, K1 Rnd 9: K2, \*P4, K4\* rpt btwn\* to last 2 sts, K2 Rnd 10: K1, \*P4, K4\* rpt btwn\* to last 3 sts, K3 Rnd 11: \*P4, K4\* rpt btwn\* around Rnd 12: P3, \*K4, P4\* rpt btwn\* to last st, P1 Rnds 13 – 16: K3, \*P4, K4\* rpt btwn\* to last 5 sts, P4, K1 Rnd 17: rpt rnd 12 Rnd 18: rpt rnd 11 Rnd 19: rpt rnd 10 Rnd 20: rpt rnd 9 Rnd 21: rpt rnd 8 Rnd 22: rpt rnd 7 Rnds 23, 25, 27: P Rnds 24, 26, 28: K

#### Yoke

With US 10.5 (6.5 mm) 32" circular needle CO 30 (32, 34, 36, 40); [32, (34, 36, 38, 40)] sts Do not join

K 1 row

Set up row: P2 for all sizes (Right Front), PM,



P4 (4, 4, 6, 6); [4 (4, 6, 6, 6)] (Right Sleeve), PM, P18 (20, 22, 24, 24); [20 (22, 20, 22, 24)] (Back), PM, P4 (4, 4, 6, 6); [4 (4, 6, 6, 6)] (Left Sleeve), PM, P2 for all sizes (Left Front)

#### **Neck Shaping**

(RS Incr) R1: \*K to 1 st before marker, M1R, K1, SM, K1, M1L\*, rpt btwn\* 3 x, K to end (WS) R2: P to end R3: Rpt R1 R4: P to end, CO 1 st R5: Rpt R1, CO 1 st R6: P to end, CO 2 sts R7: Rpt R1, CO 2 sts R8: Rpt R6 R9: Rpt R7 Nxt row: P to end, CO 6 (8, 10, 8, 10); [8 (10, 8, 10, 12)] sts for center Front Join to work in rnds, being careful not to twistin ST ST working incrs as estb, K across Left Front, and Left Sleeve, place a BOR marker between the 2 raglan sts before the Back Cont to Incr 8 sts every other round to 58 (64, 68, 76, 82); [60 (66, 72, 78, 84)] Back sts btwn markers Divide for Body and Sleeves

Nxt Rnd: K Back sts to first marker, RM, K1, place sleeve sts on holder, RM, Slip nxt st to holder, CO 4 (4, 6, 6, 8); [6 (6, 8, 8, 8)] sts, K1, K Front sts to nxt marker, RM, K1, place sleeve sts on holder, RM, slip 1 st to holder, CO 4 (4, 6, 6, 8); [6 (6, 6, 8, 8)] sts, K1, slip BOR marker, K1, Joining Front and Back

#### Body

Stockinette Stitch Pullover

Cont even in rnds to 2.5" less than desired length if **not** knitting <u>Optional Bottom Band</u> Adjust number of sts if necessary to multiple of 4 on nxt rnd by decr evenly around using K2tog Change to smaller 32" circular needle and work in 2x2 Rib for 2.5" BO all sts in patt with one size larger knitting needle.

#### **Optional Bottom Band Pullover**

Cont even in rnds to approx 7.5 (7.5, 7.75, 7.75, 8); [10.5 (10.75, 10, 9.5, 9.25)]" from divide Adjust number of sts if necessary to multiple of 8 on nxt rnd by decr evenly around using K2tog Work Optional Bottom Band Patt Change to smaller 32" circular needle and work in 2x2 Rib for 3 rnds BO all sts in patt with one size larger knitting needle **Sleeves** 

Place Left Sleeve sts on larger 16" circular needle CO 4 (4, 6, 6, 8); [6 (6, 8, 8, 8)] sts Join to work in rnds Place BOR marker between CO sts

Work even for approx 1.5"

#### **Begin Decreases**

**Note:** Change to double point needles when necessary Decr rnd: K to 2 sts before marker, SKP, SM, K2tog Rpt decrs every 6 rnds, 8 (8, 9, 9, 8); [8 (10, 10, 10, 10)] x Then rpt decrs every 4 rnds, 0 (2, 2, 4, 6); [0 (0, 3, 4, 5)] x

Nxt work even if necessary to approx 14.5 (15, 16, 17.5, 18); [14.75 (16, 17, 18, 18.25)]" or desired length from underarm minus 2"

Adjust number of sts if necessary to multiple of 4 on nxt rnd by decr evenly around using K2tog

Change to smaller size double point needles

Work in 2x2 Rib for 2"

BO all sts in patt with one size larger needle Rpt for Rightsleeve

### Neckband

With smaller size 16" circular needle, attach yarn to raglan sts ready to work Back neck PU and K in each CO st around Back and Sleeve, PU and K 3 sts for every 4 rows along Front, then PU and K each center Front CO st, then PU and K3 sts for every 4 rows along Front to Sleeve, PU and K each rem CO st

Adjust number of sts if necessary to multiple of 4 on nxt rnd by decr evenly around using K2tog Work in 2x2 Rib patt to desired length or approx 1.5 - 2.5''

## Finishing

Sew underarm seams

Weave in ends

Block to measurements if necessary
