Womens Small (Medium, Large, 1X, 2X); Mens [Small (Medium, Large, 1X, 2X)] Instructions are for smallest size, with changes for other sizes in parentheses

Finished Measurements:

Chest: 36 (39, 43, 47, 51); [37 (41, 44, 48, 52)]"

Length: 25 (26, 27, 27, 28); [27.(27.5, 28, 29, 30)]"

Materials:

- Cascade Yarns[®] Cherub Chunky; 55% Nylon / 45% Acrylic; 100 g (3.5 oz) / 136.7 yds (125 m)
- 9 (9, 10, 10, 11); [9, (10, 10, 11, 11)] skeins color #113 (Silver Heather)
- US 8 (5 mm) and US 10 (6 mm) 32" and 16" circular needles, US 9 (5.5 mm), and US 8 (5 mm) double point needles, or sizes to obtain gauge
- 1 Stitch Marker
- 2 Locking Stitch Marker
- 1 Long Stitch Holder
- 4 Stitch Holders
- Yarn Needle

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Gauge:

17 sts x 21 rows = 4" (10 cm) in Stockinette Stitch on US 10 (6 mm)

To save time, take time to check gauge by knitting a $6^{\prime\prime}x~6^{\prime\prime}$ swatch

Pattern Stitches

Stockinette Stitch in the round Every Rnd: K

2x2 Rib in the round

Every Rnd: *K2, P2* rpt btwn*









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Optional Front Band (by sizes)

(RS) R1: K4 (2, 3, 4, 3); [3 (4, 4, 3, 4)], *P1, K5* rpt btwn*, end K4 (2, 3, 4, 3); [3 (4, 4, 3, 4)]

(WS) R2: K3 (1, 2, 3, 2); [2 (3, 3, 2, 3)], *P1, K1, P1, K3* rpt btwn*, end K3 (1, 2, 3, 2); [2 (3, 3, 2, 3)]

Rpt R1 and R2

Body

With US 8 (5 mm) 32" circular needle

CO 140 (152, 164, 176, 192); [148 (160, 172, 188, 200)] sts

Place BOR marker

Join, being careful not to twist sts

Work in 2x2 Rib for approx 2 (2, 2.5, 2.5, 3); [2.5 (2.5, 2.5, 3, 3)]"

Change to US 10 (6 mm) 32" circular needle

Nxt Rnd (Incr): K and Incr using Kfb, 10 (14, 18, 22, 26); [10 (14, 14, 18, 22)] sts evenly spaced in rnd – 150 (166, 182, 198, 218); [158 (174, 186, 206, 222)] total sts

Work in ST ST to approx 17 (17.5, 18, 18, 18.5)" [18 (18.5, 18.5, 19.5, 20)]" from CO, end WS

Begin Dividing Section

Back

(RS) Nxt Row: K75 (83, 91, 99, 109); [79 (87, 93, 103, 111)] sts, place locking stitch marker in middle of sts just worked, place rem sts on long stitch holder, TURN to work WS of Back

(WS) R1: K1, P to last st, K1

(RS) R2: K

Rpt R1 & R2 to approx 7.5 (7.5, 7.5, 7.25, 7.75); [8 (8, 8, 7.5, 8)]" from locking marker at divide, end WS

Neck Shaping

(RS) Nxt Row: K25 (28, 31, 34, 38); [27 (30, 32, 36, 38)] sts, place these sts on holder, BO center 25 (27, 29, 29, 33); [25 (27, 29, 31, 35)] sts, K to end, 25 (28, 31, 34, 38); [27 (30, 32, 36, 38)] sts rem

Left side (as RS faces you)







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(WS) R1: P1, K to last st, P1

(RS) R2 (Decr): K1, SKP, K to end

Rpt R1 and R2 to 23 (25, 27, 29, 33) [24 (27, 28, 31, 33)] sts

Cont even without decr if necessary to approx 8 (8.5, 9, 9, 9.5); [9 (9, 9.5, 9.5, 10)]" from locking marker at divide, end RS

Place **shoulder** sts on holder, leaving a long tail of yarn to work a 3-needle BO for joining shoulders

Right side (as RS faces you)

Replace sts on holder to needle ready to work WS row

Attach yarn

(WS) R1: P1, K to last st, P1

(RS) R2 (Decr): K to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1

Rpt R1 and R2 to 23 (25, 27, 29, 33); [24 (27, 28, 31, 33)] sts

Cont even without decr if necessary to approx 8 (8.5, 9, 9, 9.5); [9 (9, 9.5, 9.5, 10)]" from locking marker at divide, end RS

Place shoulder sts on holder, leaving a long tail of yarn to work a 3-needle BO for joining shoulders

Front in ST ST (Instructions for Optional Front Band is below)

Replace sts on holder to needle ready to work RS row

Attach yarn

(RS) R1: K

Place locking stitch marker in middle of row just worked

(WS) R2: K1, P to last st, K1

Rpt R1 & R2 to approx 6.5 (7, 7.25, 7, 7.5); [7 (7, 7.25, 7.25, 7.5)]" from locking marker at divide, end WS

(RS) Nxt Row: k31 (33, 36, 40, 44); [32 (35, 37, 41, 43)] sts, place these sts on holder, BO center 13 (17, 19, 21); [15 (17, 19, 21, 25)] sts, K to end, 31 (33, 36, 40, 44); [32 (35, 37, 41, 43)] sts rem

Left side (as RS faces you)

(WS) Nxt Row: P1, K to last st, P1

(RS) Nxt Row: BO 5 (5, 5, 6, 7); [5 (5, 5, 6, 6)] sts, K to end

(WS) R1: K1, P to last st, K1

(RS) R2: (Decr): K1, SKP, K to end

Rpt R1 and R2 to 23 (25, 27, 29, 32); [24 (27, 28, 31, 33)] sts

Cont even without decr if necessary to approx 8 (8.5, 9, 9, 9.5); [9 (9, 9.5, 9.5, 10)]" from locking marker at divide, end RS

Place shoulder sts on holder, leaving a long tail of yarn to work a 3-needle BO for joining shoulders.

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Right side (as RS faces you)

Replace sts on holder to needle ready to work WS row

Attach yarn

(WS) Nxt Row: K1, P to last st, K1
(RS) Nxt Row: K
(WS) Nxt Row: BO 5 (5, 5, 6, 7); [5 (5, 5, 6, 6)] sts, P to last st, K1
(RS) R1: (Decr): K to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1
(WS) R2: K1, P to last st, K1

Rpt R1 and R2 to 23 (25, 27, 29, 32); [24 (27, 28, 31, 33)] sts

Cont even without decr if necessary to approx 8 (8.5, 9, 9, 9.5); [9 (9, 9.5, 9.5, 10)]" from locking marker at divide, end RS

Place **shoulder** sts on holder, leaving a long tail of yarn to work a 3-needle BO for joining shoulders

Joining Shoulders

Work 3-Needle BO as follows:

Place shoulders sts on needles with RS tog and needle tips in same direction, with working yarn at one point. Use a 3rd needle of same size or one size larger, K the 1st st from ea needle tog, rpt for nxt st on ea needle, pass 1st st made from right needle over the 2nd st, binding off 1 st. Rpt until all sts are BO

Optional Front Band

Replace sts on holder to needle ready to work RS row

Attach yarn

(RS) R1: K

Place locking stitch marker in middle of row just worked

(WS) R2: K1, P to last st, K1

Rpt R1 & R2 to approx 1.25 (1.5, 1.5, 1.25, 1.5); [1 (1, 1, 1, 1)]" from locking marker at divide, end WS

Change to size US 9 (5.5 mm)

K 4 rows

Work in Optional Front_Band Patt according to size for approx 3 (3, 3.25, 3.5, 3.5); [3.5 (3.5, 4, 4, 4.5)]" end WS

K 4 rows

Change to size US 10 (6.0 mm)

(RS) R1: K (WS) R2: K1, P to last st, K1

Rpt R1 & R2 to approx 6.5 (7, 7.25, 7, 7.5); [7 (7, 7.25, 7.25, 7.5)]" from locking marker at divide, end WS

(RS) Nxt Row: k31 (33, 36, 40, 44); [32 (35, 37, 41, 43)] sts, place these sts on holder, BO center 13 (17, 19, 19, 21); [15 (17, 19, 21, 25)] sts, K to end, 31 (33, 36, 40, 44); [32 (35, 37, 41, 43)] sts

Left side (as RS faces you)

(WS) Nxt Row: P1, K to last st, P1 (RS) Nxt Row: BO 5 (5, 5, 6, 7); [5 (5, 5, 6, 6)] sts, K to end (WS) R1: K1, P to last st, K1 (RS) R2 (Decr): K1, SKP, K to end

Rpt R1 and R2 to 23 (25, 27, 29, 32;) [24 (27, 28, 31, 33)] sts

Cont even without decr if necessary to approx 8 (8.5, 9, 9, 9.5); [9 (9, 9.5, 9.5, 10)]" from locking marker at divide, end RS

Place **shoulder** sts on holder, leaving a long tail of yarn to work a 3-needle BO for joining shoulders

Right side (as RS faces you)

Replace sts on holder to needle ready to work WS row

Attach yarn

(WS) Nxt Row: K1, P to last st, K1 (RS) Nxt Row: K (WS) Nxt Row: BO 5 (5, 5, 6, 7); [5 (5, 5, 6, 6)] sts, P to last st, K1

(RS) R1: (Decr): K to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1 (WS) R2: K1, P to last st, K1

Rpt R1 and R2 to 23 (25, 27, 29, 32); [24 (27, 28, 31, 33)] sts

Cont even without decr if necessary to approx 8 (8.5, 9, 9, 9.5); [9 (9, 9.5, 9.5, 10)]" from locking marker at divide, end RS

Place **shoulder** sts on holder, leaving a long tail of yarn to work a 3-needle BO for joining shoulders

Joining Shoulders

Work 3-Needle BO as follows:

Place shoulders sts on needles with RS tog and needle tips in same direction, with working yarn at one point. Use a 3rd needle of same size or one size larger, K the 1st st from ea needle tog, rpt for nxt st on ea needle, pass 1st st made from right needle over the 2nd st, binding off 1 st. Rpt until all sts are BO

Sleeves

Attach yarn at underarm

With US 10 (6 mm) 16" circular needle, PU and K35 (37, 39, 39, 41); [39 (39, 41, 41, 43)] sts to shoulder seam, cont to PU and K35 (37, 39, 39, 41); [39 (39, 41, 41, 43)] more sts back to underarm – 70 (74, 78, 78, 82); [78 (78, 82, 82, 86)] sts

Place BOR marker

K 2 (3, 3, 3, 4); [3 (3, 4, 4, 1)] rnds

Begin decr

Nxt Rnd: (Decr) K1, SKP, K to last 2 sts, K2tog, SM

K 5 (5, 5, 5, 5); [5 (5, 5, 5, 5)] rnds

Rpt last 6 (6, 6, 6, 6); [6 (6, 6, 6, 6)] rnds to 50 (50, 54, 54, 58); [54 (54, 58, 58, 62)] sts, then

Nxt Rnd: Rpt Decr Rnd

K 4 (4, 4, 4, 4); [4 (4, 4, 4, 4)] rnds

Rpt last 5 (5, 5, 5, 5); [5 (5, 5, 5, 5)] rnds to 36 (40, 44, 44, 48); [44 (44, 48, 48, 48)] sts

Cont even without decr if necessary to approx 18.5 (19, 19, 19, 19.5); [19 (19, 19.5 19.5, 20)]" from armhole

Change to US 8 (5 mm) double point needles

Work in 2x2 Rib for approx 2 (2, 2.5, 2.5, 3); [2.5 (2.5, 2.5, 3, 3)] "

BO in Rib Patt

Finishing

<u>Neckband</u>

Attach yarn to shoulder seam ready to work across Back

With RS facing, and US 8 (5 mm) 16" circular needle, PU and K3 (4, 4, 5, 5); [4 (4, 5, 6, 6)] sts along Back Neck shaping, then PU and K25 (26, 28, 30, 32); [24 (26, 30, 30, 32)] sts across Back Neck BO, cont and PU and K3 (4, 4, 5, 5); [4 (4, 5, 6, 6)] sts to shoulder seam, PU and K5 (5, 5, 6, 6); [6 (6, 6, 6, 7)] sts along Front Neck shaping, PU and K23 (24, 26, 28, 30); [24, (26, 28, 30, 30)] sts in all Front Neck BO's, then PU and K5 (5, 5, 6, 6); [6 (6, 6, 6, 7)] sts to shoulder seam - 64 (68, 72, 80, 84); [68 (72, 80, 84, 88)] sts total

Work in 2x2 Rib and work for approx 1 (1, 1.25, 1.5, 1.5); [1.5 (1.5, 1.75, 1.75, 2)]" BO in Rib Patt

Weave in ends

Block to measurements if necessary

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
