Finished Measurements:

8.5" wide x 28"
circumference

Materials:

- Cascade Yarns® Sarasota; 60% Cotton / 40% Acrylic; 100 g (3.5 oz) / 314 yds (287.5 m)
- 1 skein of color #214 (Bright Rose)
- US 4 (3.5 mm) knitting needles or size to obtain gauge
- Yarn needle

20 sts x 32 rows = 4" (10 cm) in eyelet pattern

**Abbreviations:**

BO	= Bind off
CO	= Cast on
K	= Knit
K2tog	= Knit 2 stitches together
P	= Purl
RS	= Right side
Sl	= Slip
SSK	= Slip, slip, knit the two slipped sts together
St(s)	= Stitch(es)
WS	= Wrong side
YO	= Yarn over

[] = work instructions within brackets as many times as directed

Pattern stitches:

Left slanting eyelet:

Row 1 (RS): K7, [YO, K2tog, K2] x 7, YO, K2tog, K9.

Row 2 (WS): K6, P to last 6 sts, K6.

Row 3: K8, [YO, K2tog, K2] x 7, YO, K2tog, K8.

Row 4: Repeat row 2.

Row 5: K9, [YO, K2tog, K2] x 7, YO, K2tog, K7.

Row 6: Repeat row 2.

Row 7: K10, [YO, K2tog, K2] x 7, YO, K2tog, K6.

Row 8: Repeat row 2.

Right slanting eyelet:

Row 1 (RS): K9, [SSK, YO, K2] x 7, SSK, YO, K7.

Row 2 (WS): K6, P to last 6 sts, K6.

Row 3: K8, [SSK, YO, K2] x 7, SSK, YO, K8.

Row 4: Repeat row 2.

Row 5: K7, [SSK, YO, K2] x 7, SSK, YO, K9.

Row 6: Repeat row 2.

Row 7: K6, [SSK, YO, K2] x 7, SSK, YO, K10.

Row 8: Repeat row 2.

Begin Pattern:

CO 46 sts using any provisional CO method.

Work 2 rows in garter stitch.

*Work Rows 1-8 of Left Slanting Eyelet four times.

Work 6 rows in garter stitch.



Work Rows 1-8 of Right Slanting Eyelet four times.

Work 6 rows in garter stitch.

Repeat from * twice more. On the final repeat, only work 2 rows in garter stitch after the Right Slanting Eyelet section.

Break yarn, leaving a tail at least 4 times the width of the cowl.

Place the CO sts onto a needle. Check to make sure that all sts are mounted correctly.

Graft the CO sts to the live sts using the garter graft method:

Hold the two needles parallel to each other so that the wrong sides of the cowl are together and the yarn tail is hanging to the right edge of the front needle. Make sure the cowl is not twisted. Thread the yarn tail into a tapestry needle.

Using the tapestry needle, go through the first st on the front needle as if to p. Leave the st on the knitting needle. Go through the first st on the back needle as if to p. Leave the st on the knitting needle.

*Go through the first st on the front needle as if to k and sl st from needle. Go through the next st on the front needle as if to p and leave the stitch on the needle. Go through the first st on the back needle as if to k and sl st from needle. Go through the next st on the back needle as if to p and leave the stitch on the needle. Repeat from * until no sts remain.

Weave in ends. Block very lightly

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
