# 220 Superwash<sup>®</sup> Rinkside Sweater

# Finished size:

Chest: 36 (40, 44, 48, 52")

Back length: 22.5 (24, 26, 27, 28")

#### Materials:

- Cascade Yarns®
  220 Superwash®
  100% Superwash Wool;
  100 g (3.5oz )/
  220 yds (200 m)
- 5,( 6, 6, 7, 8) skeins of Color A: #854 (Navy)
- 1,(1,1,2,2) skeins of Color B: #1973 (Seafoam Heather)
- 1, 1, 1, 1, 1 skein Color C: 808 (Sunset Orange)
- US 7 (4.5 mm) knitting needles
- Yarn needle



# Gauge:

21 sts x 28 rows = 4" in stockinette stitch

## **Abbreviations:**

CO = Cast On K = Knit P = Purl St(s) = Stitch(es)

#### Back:

With Color A, CO 90, 100, 110, 120, 130. K for 1" (Garter Stitch)



Row 1: K Row 2: P

Do Stockinette in Color A for 1.5" Do Stockinette in Color B for 1.5" Do Stockinette in Color A for 0.5" Do Stockinette in Color C for 1.5" Do Stockinette in Color A for 0.5" Do Stockinette in Color B for 1.5"

# Change to Color A

Do stockinette until measures: 13.5", 14", 15", 15", 15" from cast on edge

Mark each edge with a stitch marker to show base of armhole

Continue in stockinette in Color A until armholes measure: 9", 10", 11", 12", 13"

Bind off all Stitches.

Place markers to show first and last 29, 34, 37, 40, 44 sts for each shoulder (this leaves 32, 32, 36, 40, 42 sts for back neck)

### Front:

With Color A, CO 90, 100, 110, 120, 130 K for 1" (Garter Stitch)

# Stockinette:

Row 1 - K Row 2 - P

Do Stockinette in Color A for 1.5" Do Stockinette in Color B for 1.5" Do Stockinette in Color A for 0.5" Do Stockinette in Color C for 1.5" Do Stockinette in Color A for 0.5" Do Stockinette in Color B for 1.5"







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Change to Color A

Do stockinette until measures: 13.5", 14", 15", 15", 15" from cast on edge

Mark each edge with a stitch marker to show base of armhole Continue in stockinette in Color A until armholes measure: 3", 3.5", 4.25", 5", 5.5"

(End on a Wrong Side (WS) row)

Place marker in the center

With Right Side (RS) facing, work to marker in center of row (Place remaining sts on stitch holder to work later)
P back to edge

Row 1: K until last 2 sts, K2tog

Row 2: P

Do Rows 1-2 a total of 12, 11, 14, 17, 17 times

Row 1: K until last 2 sts, K2tog

Row 2: P Row 3: K

Row 4: P

Do Rows 1-4 a total of 4, 5, 4, 3, 4 times

This will leave 29, 34, 37, 40, 44 sts Continue in stockinette until armholes measure: 9", 10", 11", 12", 13" Bind off all sts

Work other half of front neckline K one row from stitch holder Purl 1 row

Start shaping:

Row 1: SSK, K to end of row

Row 2: P

Do Rows 1-2 a total of 12, 11, 14, 17, 17 times

Row 1: SSK, K to end of row

Row 2: P Row 3: K Row 4: P

Do Rows 1-4 a total of 4, 5, 4, 3, 4 times

This will leave 29, 34, 37, 40, 44 sts


Continue in stockinette until armholes measure: 9", 10", 11", 12", 13"

Bind off all sts





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Do stockinette for 1.5"

# Start increases:

- 1. Kfb, K to last sts, Kfb
- 2.
- 3. K
- 4. P

Do Rows 1-4 - 12, 18, 29, 30, 25 times

(To add stripes, at approximately 9" Use Color B for 1.5" Use Color A for 0.5" Use Color C for 1.5" Use Color A for 0.5" Use Color B for 1.5" Continue in A)

#### Continue Increases for 3 smallest sizes:

- 1. Kfb, K to last sts, Kfb
- 2. F
- 3. K
- 4. P
- 5. K
- 6. P

Do Rows 1-4 - 10, 7, 1 times

There will be 90, 100, 110, 120, 130 sts Work in stockinette until measures 19, 20, 22, 22, 22" from cast on edge Bind off all sts

# **Block pieces**

Sew shoulder seams.

Sew sleeve tops to the front and back between armhole markers

See sleeve and side seams

Using a US 5 needle, begin at shoulder not seamed.

With Color B, Pick up and K 1 sts for each BO sts along back of neck (32, 32, 36, 40, 42 sts)



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# For front of the neck:

Row 1: Pick up and knit 3 sts for every 4 rows down to center of neck.

Row 2: M1 at the base of the V-neck shaping, PM.

Row 3: Pick up and knit 3 sts for every 4 rows. (Make sure you have an odd number of sts)

PM at beginning of rnd.

With US 7

1: \*[K1, P1]; repeat from \* to marker, SM, K1, \*\*
[K1, P1];
repeat from \*\* to end of rnd.

2: \*[K1, P1]; repeat from \*to 2 sts before marker, SSK, SM, K1, K2tog, \*\*[K1, P1]; repeat from \*\* to end of rnd.

Change to Color C



- 3: \*[K1, P1]; repeat from \* to marker, SM, K1, \*\*[K1, P1]; repeat from \*\* to end of rnd.
- 4: \*[K1, P1]; repeat from \*to 2 sts before marker, SSK, SM, K1, K2tog, \*\*[K1, P1]; repeat from \*\* to end of rnd.

Change to Color B

- 5: \*[K1, P1]; repeat from \* to marker, SM, K1, \*\*[K1, P1]; repeat from \*\* to end of rnd.
- 6: \*[K1, P1]; repeat from \*to 2 sts before marker, SSK, SM, K1, K2tog, \*\*[K1, P1]; repeat from \*\* to end of rnd.

BO loosely.

Weave in ends.

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
