



## Fabric Stars

### Supplies

- Assorted quilting cottons
  - Fat Quarters work great for most sizes.
  - The largest size star does require yardage.
  - This is a great way of using up scraps
- For Hanging:
  - Ribbon, rick rack, etc.
  - All-purpose thread
  - Hand sewing needle
- Scissors
- Tweezers – helpful for the smallest size

### Cutting

- Cut your fabric into strips according to the chart below.
  - You will need four strips per star
  - Make & Take size was 4 ½"

FINISHED STAR SIZE (APPROXIMATE)	STRIP SIZE
2 ½"	2" x 12"
3 ½"	3 ¼" x 12"
4 ½"	4" x 22"
5 ½"	5" x 27"

### Pressing

- Fold each strip in half lengthwise wrong sides together and press.
- Open the fabric strip, fold the long raw edges in to meet at the crease and press.
  - This is the same as if you were making double fold bias tape, only wider.
- Repeat steps for all of your strips.
