



Garment 204: Flat Front Pants & Shorts Advanced Beginner/Intermediate

The Pietra and Emerson pants & shorts are the best of both worlds; a flat front, mid or high-waisted silhouette with the comfort of an elastic waist in the back. Both patterns give you a polished look and are so comfortable you'll never want to take them off. The Ramblers are designed specifically for men and include the same pull-on comfort and an elastic waistband that extends all the way around.

The Pietras feature lengthening panels in the front with slanted hip pockets and a hidden waist stay. Choose between four leg styles: a wide leg in floor-skimming or cropped length, a slim and tapered leg, or gently flared shorts.

The Emersons have front pleats and slanted side pockets with the option of a mid rise that hits just below the natural waist or a high rise that sits over the belly button. Choose between shorts or a cropped wide leg. You can also learn how to alter the pattern into full length pants.

The Ramblers were designed to be loose without being baggy and feature a faux fly, slightly tapered legs, slanted side pockets and back patch pockets. They also include a built-in belt and optional side patch pockets.

Fit is always important, especially with pants, so we will start off the first day of class sewing a test version to try on and see if any adjustments are needed to be made to the pattern to fit you better. Once we're satisfied with the fit, we will start working on our final versions confident that when completed our pants (or shorts) will look amazing.

Prerequisite: Garment 201 or equivalent experience.

- Fabric
 - See pattern for fabric suggestions and required yardage.
 - **Please make sure to PREWASH and IRON your fabric prior to class.**
 - Purchase the same amount of muslin as you would your fashion fabric
 - It is **NOT** necessary to prewash your muslin as it will only be used for testing purposes and not for actual wear.
- Matching thread

Please take your measurements and cut out your **pattern and muslin** ahead of the first day of class. If you would like to preserve your pattern to make additional sizes later, we have Swedish Tracing paper available instore you can trace your pattern onto.
