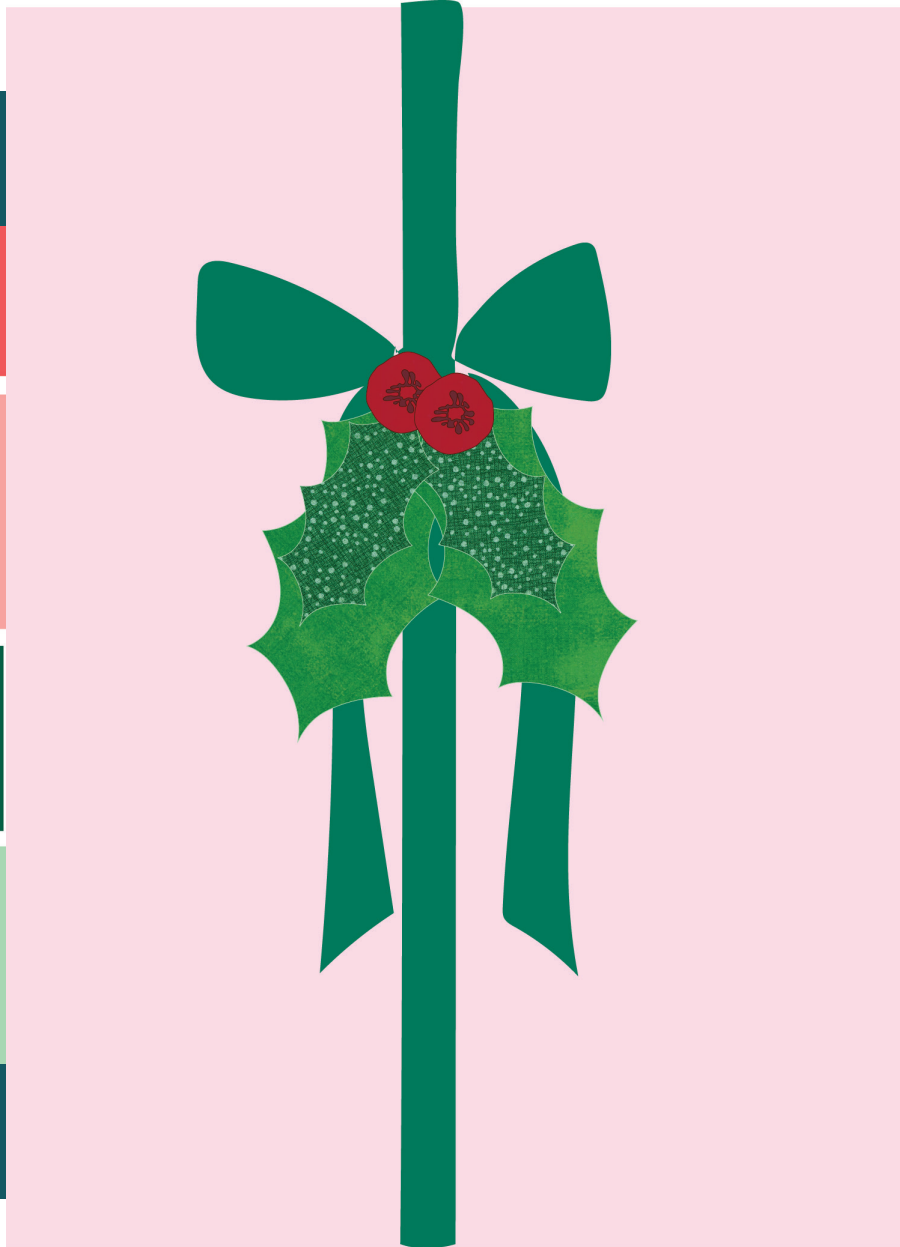




JOLLY HOLLY



Featuring the Jolly Holly acrylic template by Moda Fabrics

A festive project for decor and displays!



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CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

For the small version (tags, ornaments):
Makes 1 large leaf, 2 small leaves, 1 berry

FROM SELECTED FABRICS AND STABILIZER:

- Cut (4) 6" x 7" rectangles of assorted green print fabrics for holly leaves
- Cut (2) 6" x 7" rectangles of double-sided fusible fleece (Stock #1893) for holly leaves
- Cut (1) 5" x 5" square of coordinating red print fabric for holly berry

TOOLS AND NOTIONS:

- Moda Fabrics Jolly Holly acrylic template (Stock #6021M) or printed paper template (see next page)
- 45mm Clover Quick Yo-Yo Maker (Stock #8701)
- Coordinating floss (we recommend Aurifloss)
- Chenille needle (Stock #JJ188 18)
- OPTIONAL: Fabric pen (we recommend Sewline, Stock #FAB50034)

For the large version (display):
Makes 1 large leaf, 1 small leaf, 1 berry

FROM SELECTED FABRICS AND STABILIZER:

- Cut (2) 18" x 9½" rectangles of coordinating green print fabrics for large holly leaf
- Cut (1) 18" x 9½" rectangle of double-sided fusible extra-firm stabilizer (Stock #72F) for large holly leaf
- Cut (2) 13" x 7" rectangles of coordinating green print fabrics for small holly leaf
- Cut (1) 13" x 7" rectangle of double-sided fusible extra-firm stabilizer (Stock #72F) for small holly leaf
- Cut (1) 9" x 9" square of coordinating red print fabric for holly berry

TOOLS AND NOTIONS:

- Moda Fabrics Jolly Holly printed paper template (download via QR code on next page)
- 90mm Clover Quick Yo-Yo Maker (Stock #8708)
- Fabric pen (we recommend Sewline, Stock #FAB50034)

PIECING INSTRUCTIONS

FOR THE SMALL VERSION:

1. Following manufacturer's instructions, fuse green print rectangles to each side of the fusible fleece rectangles.
2. Using the acrylic Moda Jolly Holly template and a small rotary cutter, cut 1 large leaf from one prepared rectangle and 2 small leaves from the other prepared rectangle. Or, use a fabric pen to trace the acrylic or paper template onto the prepared rectangles and cut out the leaf shapes with scissors.
3. Using 4-6 strands of floss and a chenille needle, stitch a decorative running stitch down the center length of each leaf.
4. Following the manufacturer's instructions, make a fabric yo-yo using the red print square.
5. Arrange your large and small holly leaves and yo-yo holly berry as desired. Tack together using 4-6 strands of floss or a bit of hot glue.

FOR THE LARGE VERSION:

1. Following manufacturer's instructions, fuse green print rectangles to each side of the extra-firm stabilizer rectangles.
2. Download and print the paper templates. Following the instructions on the printout, cut out and tape together the template sections. Use a fabric pen to trace the paper template onto the prepared rectangles and cut out the leaf shapes with scissors.
3. Using a quilting ruler and fabric pen, mark a line down the center of each leaf, lengthwise.
4. Machine-stitch 1/8" around the edges of each leaf and 1/8" on each side of the center line.
5. Following the manufacturer's instructions, make a fabric yo-yo using the red print square.
6. Arrange your large and small holly leaves and yo-yo holly berry as desired. Tack together using a bit of hot glue.



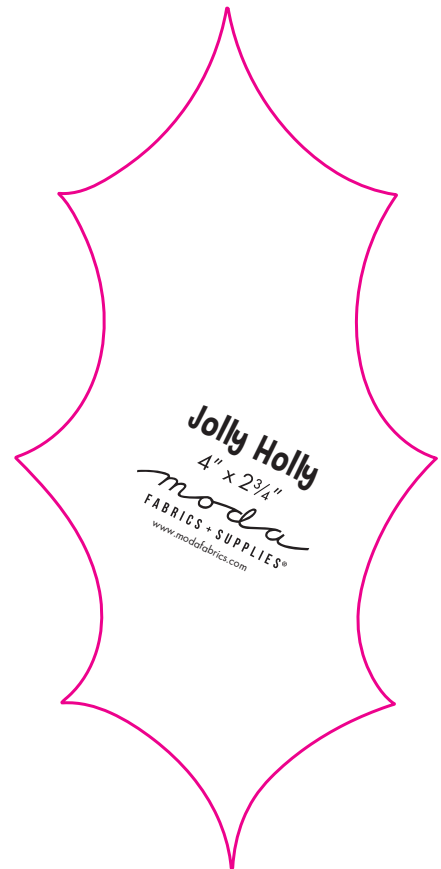
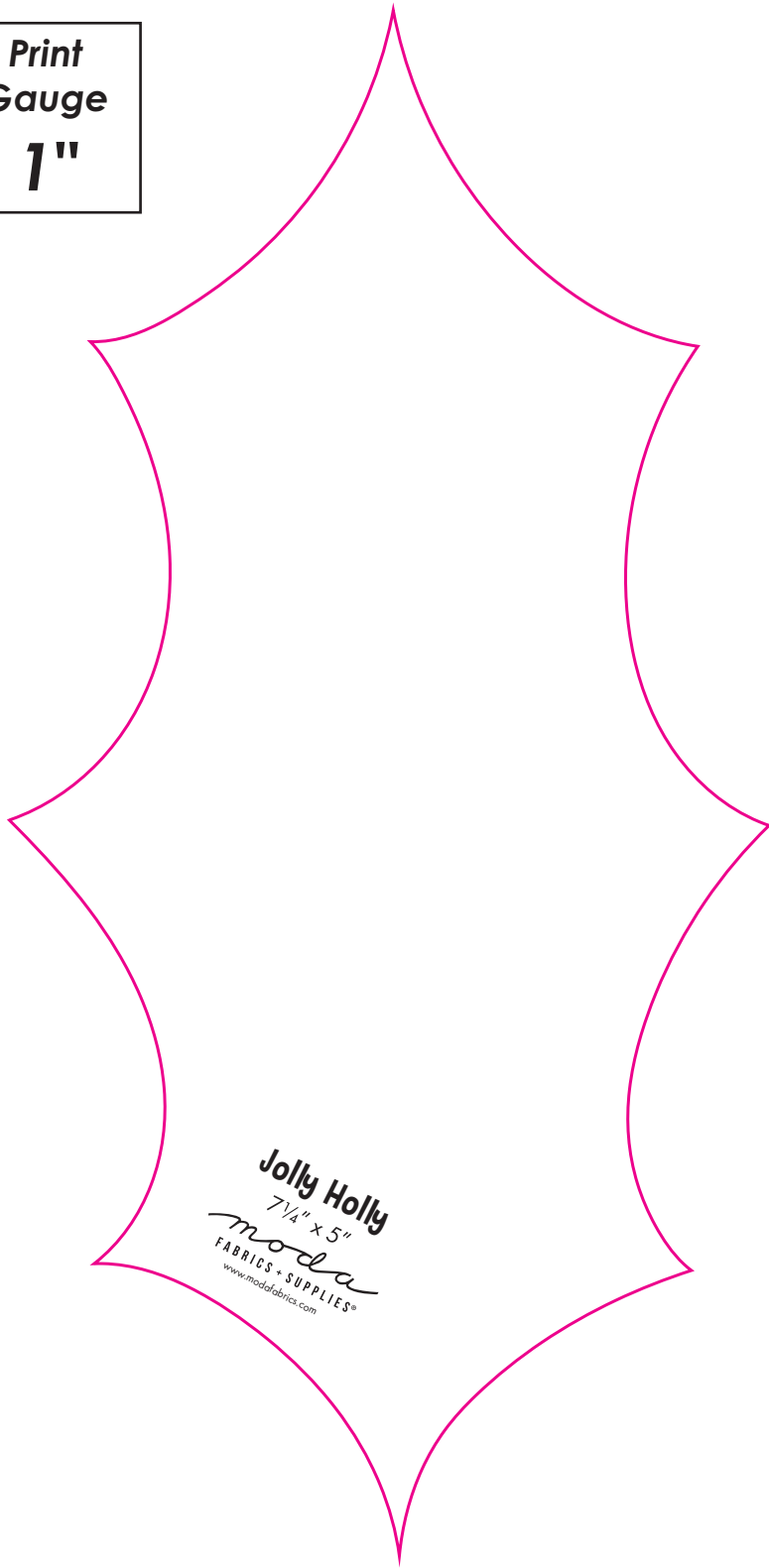

FINISHED SIZES: About 7½" x 5½" (small),
about 17½" x 9" (large)

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FABRIC & NOTION REQUIREMENTS

For the small version (tags, ornaments): Makes 1 large leaf, 2 small leaves, 1 berry

- (2-4) fat eighths of assorted green prints
- (1) 5" x 5" square of coordinating red print fabric
- (1) 7" x WOF strip of double-sided fusible fleece (Stock #1893)
- Moda Fabrics Jolly Holly acrylic template (Stock #6021M) or printed paper template (inside)
- 45mm Clover Quick Yo-Yo Maker (Stock #8701)
- Coordinating floss (we recommend Aurifloss)
- Chenille needle (Stock #JJ188 18)
- OPTIONAL: Fabric pen (we recommend Sewline, Stock #FAB50034)

For the large version (display): Makes 1 large leaf, 1 small leaf, 1 berry

- (4-6) fat quarters of assorted green prints
- (1) 9" x 9" square of coordinating red print fabric
- (1) 18" x 22" rectangle of double-sided extra-firm stabilizer (Stock #72F)
- Moda Fabrics Jolly Holly printed paper template (download via QR code below!)
- 90mm Clover Quick Yo-Yo Maker (Stock #8708)
- Fabric pen (we recommend Sewline, Stock #FAB50034)

Project idea: Stitch several large holly leaves end to end, and then tack a couple of small leaves and yo-yo berries where the large leaves are joined to create a garland for a mantel, tree, or staircase!
