



Quilting 101: Basics Advanced Beginner

Have you ever been curious about quilting but didn't know where to start? Or been overwhelmed by the sheer number of fabrics, tools and pattern options? This class will take you through the entire process from cutting to binding as you make a throw sized quilt. You will learn what common acronyms mean like WOF and HST. We will go over tools and techniques that lead to easier and more accurate cutting and sewing that can be applied to future projects.

Prerequisite: Sewing 101 or equivalent experience.

SUPPLY LIST FOR CLASS

- Easy Does It 3-Yard Quilts by Donna Robertson
 - We will be making the "Best Friends" quilt
- 1 yard each of 3 coordinating quilting cottons for quilt top
 - Smaller prints can be easier to work with as the largest squares are about 4". Large scale prints will be chopped up
- ½ yard quilting cotton for binding
 - We will be using a double fold binding
 - This can be one of your 3 fabrics or something different
- 3 yards of quilting cotton for quilt back
 - Print will run horizontally on the back
- 1 ½ yards quilt batting at least 90" wide
- Coordinating thread for sewing and quilting (will be visible)
- Quilter's Magic Wand
